

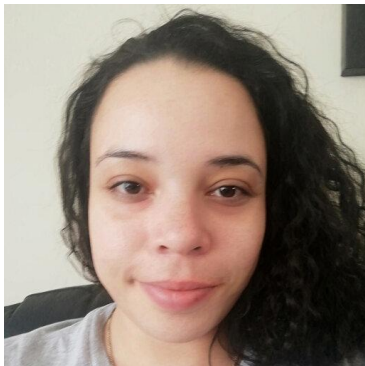
In Memory of Priscilla McGreer
